DR. FISHER HUMPHREYS, LEADER

Dr. Fisher Humphreys, widely known and acclaimed teacher and preacher, will be our guest Bible teacher on January 14-16 for our Annual Winter Bible Study.

Fisher Humphreys teaches courses in Christian doctrine in the Beeson Divinity School of Samford University, the Alabama Baptist school where he has taught since 1990.

Dr. Humphreys will deal with the Christian doctrine of the Trinity. Theme for the Bible Conference will be "What's the Difference? Knowing the God of the Bible" and will focus on what it means for us to know God as Father, Son, and Spirit.

In 2003, Dr. Humphreys was named by students as the outstanding faculty member in the divinity school. "This award recognizes the enduring influence of our wonderful Beeson faculty on the lives and ministries of our students," said the Beeson dean in presenting the award to Dr. Humphreys. "Each of our faculty members is invested in the spiritual and pastoral formation of our students as well as in their academic preparation for service in Christ's church. It is appropriate that Dr. Fisher Humphreys receive this first award," said the dean.

He is the author of fourteen books and numerous journal articles. Additionally he has written lessons for use in Sunday School and in other settings.

Prior to coming to joining the Beeson faculty, Humphreys was professor of theology at New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary where he served as editor of a journal of theology and ministry, *The Theological Educator*. He is a frequent guest lecturer at colleges and seminaries and guest teacher in churches. He was ordained by the First Baptist Church, Columbus, Mississippi and has served as pastor of churches in Mississippi, Alabama, and Illinois.

He and his wife Caroline have two adult children and two granddaughters.

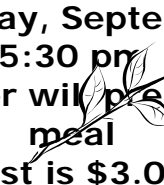
